STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Maintenance of Bridges on State Aid and Third Class Roads.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 20, § 94, amended. Section 94 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 365 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 94. Maintenance of bridges built or rebuilt. All costs of maintenance of bridges built or rebuilt under the provisions of sections 84 to 92, inclusive, and sections 96 to 98, inclusive, shall be borne entirely by the state. The provisions of this section shall also apply to the maintenance of the bridge between Machiasport and East Machias, and the bridges built under the Program of U. S. Works Program, Flood Relief Projects (1936 allotments).'
