STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Retail Grocer Representative on Milk Control Board.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 28, § 2, amended. The 1st sentence of section 2 of chapter 28 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The milk control, as heretofore established, shall consist of 2 producers, a dealer 2 dealers, one of whom shall be a retail grocer or a duly recognized representative acceptable by the trade, and a producer-dealer all of whom shall be residents of the state.'
