STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Investment of Sinking Funds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 15, § 15, amended. Section 15 of chapter 15 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 15. Relating to investment of sinking funds. The treasurer, with the advice approval of the governor and the bank commissioner, shall from time to time as funds appropriated for any sinking fund established by law are received into the treasury, invest the same, with the income thereof, as it accrues, in any bonds of Maine, of any other New England state, or in the registered bonds of the United States; and as such bonds fall due and are paid, the proceeds thereof shall be reinvested in like manner.'
