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**RESOLVE, in Favor of the George Green Estate.**

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**George Green Estate; appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$10,000 to be paid to the George Green Estate as full and final settlement against the state for damage to property caused by the building of a bridge at Wessaweakeag river, South Thomaston, by the state highway commission; said sum to be paid from the general highway fund.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

In the building of a bridge by the state highway commission, a dam was destroyed without authority of law, to the damage of the estate.
