## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Amending the Unemployment Compensation Law as to Benefit Eligibility Conditions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 24, § 4, sub-§ (c), amended. Subsection (c) of section 4 of chapter 24 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- '(c) He is able to work and is available for work and in addition to having complied with section 4 (b) above is himself actively seeking work at his usual or customary trade, occupation, profession or business or in such other trade, occupation, profession or business as his prior training or experience shows him to be fitted or qualified.'
