RESOLVE, to Open Perry Pond, Aroostook County, to Ice Fishing.

Perry pond opened to ice fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Perry pond, in the town of Benedicta, County of Aroostook, to ice fishing.

This pond has pickerel, perch and some trout and salmon.
