**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Royal River, in the County of
Cumberland.**

Regulating fishing in Royal river, in the county of Cumberland. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Royal river, in the towns of North Yarmouth and Yarmouth, from the Dunn's Depot bridge, down to the Weston dam, in the county of Cumberland, to ice fishing.
