RESOLVE Providing for a Multi-Purpose Building at the Oak Grove School.

Oak Grove School; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$50,000 from the general fund of the state to be expended by the Oak Grove School for constructing a combination instructional-study-gymnasium building.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Oak Grove School was founded in 1849. It is a nonprofit corporation which provides secondary educational opportunities for girls. More functional building space is needed to meet the demands of a growing enrollment. Furthermore, the construction of this building unit will complete the erection of a quadrangle of modern fireproof facilities.

Beacuse of this need, the corporators of the Oak Grove School request that \$50,000 be appropriated to be expended for the construction of a combination instructional-study-gymnasium building.
