STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Financing Community School Districts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 92-D, amended. The 1st sentence of section 92-D of chapter 37 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 357 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'To procure funds for authorized purposes of the district, the said district is hereby authorized to issue its bonds and notes, but shall not incur a total indebtedness in excess of 5% of the total state valuation of all of the participating towns.'
