**AN ACT Relative to Payment of Damage Caused by Collision Between
Motor Vehicle and Deer.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 85-A, additional. Section 85 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 85-A, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 85-A. No state agency shall pay any claim for damages arising from any collision between a motor vehicle and a deer.’
