STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Application of Health Laws to Certain Grocery Stores.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 158-A, additional. Chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 158-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 158-A. Limitation. The provisions of sections 152 to 158, inclusive, and any rules and regulations issued thereunder shall not apply to grocery stores which serve ice cream cones as the only food to be consumed on the premises.'
