AN ACT Relative to Registration of Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 93, amended. The last paragraph of section 93 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Each person who registers a deer under section 88 shall pay a registration fee of \$1. All deer registration fees so paid shall be transmitted to the treasurer of state through the commissioner within 10 days after the close of the deer hunting season and shall be held in a fund for the payment of bounties on bobcats. Bobcat bounties paid under the provisions of this paragraph shall be established by the commissioner at not less than \$25 nor more than \$50 each and shall be approved, certified and paid as provided in section 102.'
