STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Stop Intersections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 78, amended. Section 78 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 98 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended by adding after the 1st paragraph thereof the following:

'The state highway commission may also designate any intersection as a stop intersection and erect stop signs at one or more entrances. The same rules and penalties shall apply in regard to these stop signs as are in effect for stop signs at "through ways".'
