STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Aeronautical Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14, § 167, amended. The 6th sentence of section 167 of chapter 14 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 337 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

The aeronautics commission is authorized and directed to expend such sums for interest and retirement as are necessary to meet the provisions of bond issues to match federal funds for the construction and improvement of airports throughout the state and so much of the aeronautical fund as may be necessary for the purposes of carrying out the duties imposed upon it by law and to expend any unexpended balance in such fund to assist in construction, repair and the maintenance of, and the removal of snow from, municipal, state and federal airports in this state, and assist in the construction and maintenance of a system of air marking, in such manner and in such amounts as it shall deem equitable.'
