STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Number of Medical Examiners in Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 258, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 258 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The number of medical examiners so to be appointed shall be as follows: for the counties of Franklin, Knox, Lincoln, Piscataquis, Sagadahoc, Somerset and Waldo, 2 each; for the counties of Hancock, Oxford and Washington, 3 each; for the counties of Arcostock, Kennebec and York, 4 each; for the counties of Androscoggin and Arcostock, 5; and for the counties of Cumberland and Penobscot, 6 each; and they shall be appointed with reference to territorial distribution.'
