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AN ACT Relating to Paroled and Discharged Prisoners from State Prison.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 136, § 18-A, additional. Chapter 136 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 18-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 18-A. Paroled or discharged prisoners, record to be forwarded to state police. Whenever any prisoner, who has been convicted of an offense under the provisions of sections 10, 11 or 12 of chapter 117 or under the provisions of section 6 of chapter 121, is released upon parole, or discharged in full execution of his sentence, the warden of the prison shall make and forward to the state police a copy of the prison record of said prisoner together with a statement of any fact or facts which he may deem necessary for a full comprehension of the case.'
