AN ACT Relating to Parolees from Reformatory for Men.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 70-A, additional. Chapter 23 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 70-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 70-A. Parolees; record to be forwarded to state police. Whenever any person, who has been convicted of an offense under the provisions of sections 10, 11 or 12 of chapter 117, or under the provisions of section 6 of chapter 121, is released upon parole, or otherwise discharged according to law, the superintendent shall make and forward to the state police a copy of the record of said inmate together with such other information as he may deem important for a full comprehension of the case.'
