RESOLVE, in Favor of James A. Boyle, of Portland.

James A. Boyle; credit given to. Resolved: That James A. Boyle, of Portland be given credit for 25 years service as deputy sealer and sealer of weights and measures for the city of Portland so that this credit shall be applied to any retirement benefits under the provisions of chapter 60 of the revised statutes.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Boyle was employed by the city of Portland as deputy sealer and sealer of weights and measures from July, 1923 to June, 1948 at which time Mr. Boyle became employed by the state. Mr. Boyle is now a member of the state retirement system and state law gives no credit for his previous municipal credit.
