STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Salary of Register of Deeds and Clerk Hire in Office of Register of Deeds, Androscoggin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 231, amended. That part of section 231 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to the salary of the register of deeds of Androscoggin county, as amended by section 1 of chapter 260 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Androscoggin, \$2,400 \$3,000,'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to clerk hire in the office of register of deeds, Androscoggin county, as amended by section 2 of chapter 260 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$3,250 \$7,670;'
