AN ACT to Provide for Better Patrol of Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 13, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:

‘The chief of the state police shall assign 75 men to highway patrol duty to enforce the laws of the road.’

Sec. 2. Appropriation. A sum sufficient to execute the duty imposed by this act is hereby appropriated from the general highway fund for each of the fiscal years 1949-1950 and 1950-1951.
