STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Workmen's Compensation Act.

Be in enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 26, § 10, amended. Section 10 of chapter 26 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 10. Compensation begins on 8th day of incapacity. Compensation for incapacity to work on account of an injury aforesaid shall begin on the 8th day of incapacity, the day of the accident to be counted as the first day thereof; provided, however, that when incapacity continues thereafter for a period of 6 consecutive weeks or more, compensation shall be allowed from the day the incapacity began.'
