## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 94th LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1535, L. D. 810, Bill, "An Act Relating to Shipment of Clams."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof a new section to be numbered 3, to read as follows:

"Sec. 3. R S., c. 34, \$95-A, additional. Chapter 34 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 95-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 95-A. Airplane transportation of clams, quahogs and mussels regulated; penalty. No person shall transport, attempt to transport or offer for transportation by airplane any clams, quahogs or mussels either in the shell or shucked unless such clams, quahogs or mussels either in the shell or shucked shall bear a transportation tag issued by the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries stating that the same may be so transported and bearing the signature of a coastal warden. The pilot or owner of an airplane, other than those of regular transport lines, shall procure from the commissioner a permit to transport any such clams, quahogs or mussels either in the shell or shucked by air and shall make such returns to the commissioner as he shall designate by rule and regulation. Whoever violates any provision of this section shall be punished as set forth in section 144.'"
