AN ACT Relating to Other Purposes for Which Cities and Towns May
Raise Money.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 80, § 91, amended. Section 91 of chapter 80 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 40 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof a new sentence, to read as follows:

‘Cities and towns may also raise money for insurance of their officers, agents, servants, fire department or association officers and members, including call or volunteer firemen, against public liability and property damage resulting from the negligent acts of commission or omission of any such personnel while operating motor vehicles owned or rented by any such municipality and in use upon city or town business be it governmental, corporate or proprietary.’
