IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Records of Persons Buying or Selling Dogs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 88, § 24-A, additional. Chapter 88 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 24-A, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 24-A. Persons buying or selling dogs to keep record. All persons or kennels engaged in buying or selling dogs must keep record of from whom bought, and to whom sold, which record shall be opened to inspection by local police officers or humane agents.’
