STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Fishways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 10, amended. Section 10 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end of the 4th paragraph thereof a new sentence, to read as follows:

'Whenever the owners or occupants of said dam or obstruction are ordered to erect a suitable fishway, the commissioner shall pay 1,000 towards or $\frac{1}{2}$ of the cost of such erection, whichever sum is the lesser; provided, however, that the provisions of this sentence shall not apply to unorganized territory.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated, annually, from the general fund of the state to be paid to the department of inland fisheries and game, the sum of \$10,000. Any balance of appropriation remaining unexpended at the end of any fiscal period shall not lapse, but shall remain a continual carrying account available for the same in any succeeding fiscal year.
