**RESOLVE to Provide for a Fish Screen at Hot Brook Lake, in the County
of Aroostook.**

Fish screen at Hot brook lake. Resolved: That the Danforth Rod and Gun Club be, and hereby is, granted the privilege of installing a fish screen at the lower end of Hot Brook lake, Aroostook county. All expense shall be borne, and materials and labor furnished, by the Danforth Rod and Gun Club.

It is desired to install this screen so that the lake may be stocked with brown trout.
