STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT to Clarify the Law Relating to Clerks of the Judicial Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 111, amended. Section 111 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following words:

'and where an election is held following a vacancy caused by death, resignation or otherwise, the election shall not be for the unexpired term but for a full term of 4 years beginning January 1st following the election.'

Sec. 2. Application. The provisions of this act shall also apply to the clerks of the judicial courts heretofore elected and now in office.
