STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to Provide for a Refund of Contributions to Certain Teachers.

Refund of contributions to certain teachers. Resolved: That there shall be paid to those teachers who were originally eligible to the provisions of the old non-contributory teachers' retirement law and who voluntarily joined the Maine Teachers' Retirement Association, such amounts as such teachers contributed to the said Maine Teachers' Retirement Association from the date of so joining Maine Teachers' Retirement Association to July 1, 1945, the date on and after which all teachers were required to make retirement contributions.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Those teachers who voluntarily joined the Maine Teachers' Retirement Association received no credit for contributions which they had previously made and are now in the same category as those teachers who joined the system but who previous to July 1, 1945 contributed nothing toward their retirement.
