STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the State Police.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 13, § 4, amended. Section 4 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraphs:

'The chief of the state police shall assign 2 uniformed members of the force to the Maine public utilities commission to special duty to enforce the laws, rules and regulations relating to the operation of for-hire motor vehicles.

If the Maine public utilities commission shall find that additional members of the force are needed for said purpose the chief of the state police shall, at the request of the public utilities commission, assign not more than 2 additional members of the force for such service.

While engaged in such special duty, the salaries and expenses of officers so assigned shall be paid by the public utilities commission.
