STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Fees and Expenses of State Humane Agents.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 127, § 21, amended. The last sentence of section 21 of chapter 127 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'For services and expenses in conducting such investigations such agents shall be paid a reasonable sum by the county in which such services are rendered and expenses are incurred, and for their travel the same fees as are now allowed officers by law for the service of a warrant for arrest, but no county shall be liable to pay the fees of such agents for their travel outside of its lines; provided, however, that all claims of such agents for such travel and services shall first be audited and approved by the county commissioners of the county liable to pay the same. Fees for services rendered by such agents shall be the same as those received by sheriffs.'
