IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Aid to the Blind.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 276, sub-§ V, amended. Subsection V of section 276 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'V. Has not sufficient income or other resources to provide a reasonable subsistence compatible with decency and health and has no relatives liable by law for his support and able to provide such support **residing in this state;**'
