STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE Providing Funds to Repair a Portion of U. S. Highway Number One in Aroostook County.

U. S. Highway number one; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$75,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950 and the sum of \$75,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1951, to resurface, rebuild and widen U. S. highway No. 1, beginning at the Washington county line at Danforth and running in a northerly direction to the town of Houlton, a distance of 35 miles; said sum to be taken from the general highway fund and expended under the supervision of the highway commission. Any unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall be available for the same on any succeeding fiscal year.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This highway extends from Miami, Florida to Fort Kent, and is an important highway for tourist travel and for trucking. The trucks passing over this highway are much heavier than when the road was first built and it needs to be rebuilt to accommodate this heavier travel.
