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**AN ACT Relative to License to Ship Deer Skins.**

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Be in enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 87, amended. Section 87 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph, to read as follows:

‘No person except those licensed under section 105 shall ship, transport, cause to be transported or attempt to transport any deer skin beyond the limits of this state unless he has obtained a license to do so from the commissioner of inland fisheries and game and shall have attached a section of the license to the skin. Licenses to transport deer skins under the provisions of this section shall be issued by the commissioner on payment of \$1.’
