STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Regulating Wearing of Hunting and Fishing Licenses in Metal Cases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 32, amended. Section 32 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'The holder of any hunting license, fishing license or combination thereof, shall wear such license prominently displayed on the front part of the outer garment in a metal case furnished by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game at the time such license is issued, at a cost of roc to each purchaser.'
