### STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

#### AN ACT Giving the Newspapers Access to Records of Vital Statistics.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 22, § 388, amended.** The 1st sentence of section 388 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 4 of chapter 320 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The state registrar and the clerk of a municipality shall not permit inspection of the records of birth, marriage and death, marriage intentions excepted, or issue a certified copy of a certificate relating thereto, or to parts thereof, unless he is satisfied that the applicant therefor has a direct and tangible interest in the matter recorded, the decision of the state registrar or the clerk of a municipality being subject, however, to review by the superior court or any justice thereof in vacation, under the limitations of this chapter; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall be construed to bar newspaper reporters from access to such records.'
