STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Pollution of Waters of Sebago Lake Used by the Portland Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1913, c. 157, § 2, amended. The 1st sentence of section 2 of chapter 157 of the private and special laws of 1913 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No person shall baths in the waters of the Lower Bay, so called, of Sebago lake within two miles of, in which Lower Bay is located the intake of the Portland Water District, nor shall any person wash linen or other articles of personal apparel in the waters of said lake.'
