#### **AN ACT Relating to Pollution of Waters of Sebago Lake Used by the Portland Water District.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1913, c. 157, § 2, amended.** The 1st sentence of section 2 of chapter 157 of the private and special laws of 1913 is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘No person shall bath in the waters **of the Lower Bay, so called,** of Sebago lake ~~within two miles of,~~ **in which Lower Bay is located** the intake of the Portland Water District, nor shall any person wash linen or other articles of personal apparel in the waters of said lake.’
