IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

**AN ACT Relating to the Superintendent of Public Works Department of
the City of Lewiston.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. VIII, § 12, amended. Section 12 of Article VIII of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

‘The board of finance shall appoint a full-time civil engineer, who shall be subject to the authority of said board and shall be the superintendent of the department of public works. The board of finance may assign said superintendent to any department of the city for such time or times and under such rules and regulations as they may order, fix his compensation and terminate his employment at pleasure.’

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. X, § 4, amended. Section 4 of Article X of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as repealed and replaced by section 6 of chapter 86 of the private and special laws of 1943, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘Sec. 4. Employees. The board shall have full power and authority to employ such ~~superintendents, engineers,~~ inspectors foremen, agents and

employees as may be required for the administration of the affairs of the department, prescribe their duties, set their compensation subject to the approval of the board of finance and terminate their employment at pleasure.'

Sec. 3. P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. X, § 5, additional. Article X of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, to be numbered 5, to read as follows:

'Sec. 5. Superintendent of department. The full-time civil engineer appointed by the board of finance shall be the superintendent of the department of public works.'
