RESOLVE, Extending the Open Season on Gull Pond.

Open season on Gull pond extended. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to open Gull pond, situated in Dallas plantation, county of Franklin, to fly fishing only, with a daily bag limit of 1 fish, from the 1st day of October to the 15th day of the same month.
