STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the City of Bath for Loss of Taxes.

City of Bath; appropriation. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$2,551.20 to the city of Bath, to reimburse said city for the loss of taxes on land and buildings formerly taxed by said city.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The state has taken over certain land and buildings in the city of Bath to be used for the purpose of constructing an overhead pass to the Carlton Bridge. No construction has been done due to the war emergency. The sum of \$2,551.20 represents the taxes for the years 1943 and 1944 which the city of Bath would have had if the land remained taxable by such city.
