RESOLVE in Favor of Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission.

Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state, in favor of the Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission, the sum of \$30,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950 and the sum of \$30,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1951, to carry out the program of said commission in conjunction with the United States Fish and Wild Life Service.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The commission cannot function unless they are granted this appropriation.
