

STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 94th LEGISLATURE

Senate Amendment "A" to S. P. 490, L. D. 950, Bill, "An Act Relating to Interstate Transportation of Shellfish."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of the next to last paragraph thereof the following underlined sentence: '<u>The provisions of</u> this section shall apply only to holders of non-resident shellfish transportation licenses, except that holders of resident shellfish transportation licenses may ship clams beyond the limits of the state for the "steamer trade" only.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined paragraph thereof and inserting in place thereof the following underlined paragraph:

'Whoever violates any provision of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$200 nor more than \$500, or by imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment and in addition to such penalties the shellfish transportation license

shall be revoked for a period of 1 year.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof a new underlined paragraph to read as follows:

'It is the intent of the legislature that the provisions of this section are enacted for the purpose of conservation of soft-shell clam resources.'
