# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

### AN ACT Relating to the Fee for Commercial Shellfish License.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 34, § 110-A, amended.** The 2nd paragraph of section 110-A of chapter 34 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'A license designated as a commercial shellfish license shall be issued only to residents of the state who shall make written application for the same. The fee shall be \$3 and it It shall entitle the holder to dig or to take clams, quahogs and mussels for sale and to transport and sell the same in the shell within this state.'
