STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

RESOLVE in Favor of Bangor Anti-Tuberculosis Association.

Bangor Anti-Tuberculosis Association; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the Bangor Anti-Tuberculosis Association, of Bangor, the sum of \$9,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1950, and \$9,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1951, for operating the sanatorium at Bangor.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The sanatorium, for many years, has received \$3,000 per year from the state. Substantial increases in operating expenses, mainly in food and labor costs, have produced continuing deficits to a point where the directors have made public announcement of the intent to close the facility.

An increase of state subsidy from the \$3,000 per year suggested in the budget document, to the \$9,000 per year suggested in this resolve, will permit continued operation. Such an appropriation would be less than the cost to the state of caring for the patients at a state facility.
