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**AN ACT Relating to Limitation of Liquor Licenses by Towns.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 80, § 83, sub-§ XX, additional.** Section 83 of chapter 80 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapters 51 and 235 of the public laws of 1945, and by chapters 91 and 267 of the public laws of 1947, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof a new subsection to be numbered XX, to read as follows:

**'XX. Limiting the total number of liquor licenses of any particular type authorized by local option vote provided that such limitation permits a minimum of 2 licenses of each type.'**
