STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT to Confer the Power to Issue Subpoenas to the City Council, the Municipal Officers and the Civil Service Commission of the City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1927, c. 57, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 57 of the private and special laws of 1927 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 1. Clerks of courts authorized to issue summons for witnesses to appear at meetings of city council, municipal officers and civil service commission of the city of Portland; how served. The clerks of the supreme judicial and superior courts may issue summons for witnesses to attend and to produce books, records, documents and papers at any meeting of the city council, the municipal officers, or of the civil service commission of the city of Portland at which a hearing is had in any matter regarding any alleged dereliction of duty of any city officer or any person in the employ of the city, or in any matter in which a hearing is being held in accordance with the requirements of the laws of the state of Maine or the ordinances of the city of Portland. Said summons shall be served as summons are required to be served in matters before the supreme judicial or superior courts.'
