STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Maine Soldiers and Sailors in the War with Spain.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Spanish War bonus authorized. Each honorably discharged soldier and sailor or member of the armed forces, resident of the state of Maine, who served in the quota of Maine in the war with Spain, shall be paid a bonus of \$78.

Sec. 2. Adjutant general to pass on claims. The adjutant general is hereby authorized and directed to determine the validity of the claims filed with his department for said bonuses. The claims so approved by him shall be forwarded to the state controller for payment.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$40,000 to carry out the provisions of this act.
