STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Clinton Water District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1945, c. 72, § 15, amended. The 1st sentence of section 15 of chapter 72 of the private and special laws of 1945 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'All individuals, firms and corporations, whether private, public or municipal except the town of Clinton and religious, philanthropic, fraternal, benevolent and charitable organizations therein, shall pay to the treasurer of said district the rates established by said board of trustees for the service used by them, and said rates shall be uniform within the territory supplied by the district, and the water rates shall be subject to the approval of the public utilities commission.'
