STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-NINE

AN ACT to Authorize the Construction of a Wharf in Maranacook Lake at Winthrop.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Wharf in Maranacook lake authorized. The Winthrop Fish and Game Association, its successors and assigns, are hereby authorized and empowered to construct and maintain a wharf opposite land owned by the town of Winthrop in Maranacook lake in the town of Winthrop and the county of Kennebec, and to extend the same into Maranacook lake for a distance of not more than 75 feet from the shore of the lake at low water mark. The wharf shall be maintained in good condition for the free use of the public. The wharf and approach shall not cover more than 800 square feet.
