## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 94th LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1642, L. D. 935, Bill, "An Act Amending the Charter of the City of Portland re Election of Members to City Council."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 1 of said Bill, after the stricken out words, the following underlined sentence:

'It shall be the duty of the city council to revise, and if it be needful, to alter such districts, as provided for in section 1 of Article

II, in such manner as to preserve, as nearly as may be, an equal number of voters in each.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the 1st sentence of section 2 of said Bill and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:

'This act shall take effect 90 days after the adjournment of this legislature only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters of the city of Portland at the next general city election!
